Application

2012/2013 Family Application Fee: \$55 for 1 child, \$110 for 2 or more children

Woodmont Christian Preschool has a lottery based admission process for applicants not currently enrolled in the program and a tenure based process for currently enrolled applicants. Applications are accepted all year, but priority is given to those applications received before the Lottery Application Deadline.

Applications are given priority in the following order:

1. Woodmont Christian Church members currently enrolled in WCPS
2. Current children enrolled in WCPS
3. Woodmont Christian Church members new to WCPS
4. WCPS legacy/alumni
5. New applicant families

The lottery is processed by an Admissions Committee, which meets during the second week of February to complete enrollment for the following school year. The Admissions Committee reviews the applications and makes placement recommendations. Every effort is made to honor each applicant's requested days. The number of children with special needs, the physical space available and the boy/girl ratio for each class may influence the specific day or days each child is assigned.

Within the first two groups listed, priority in placement will be given based on the original enrollment date of the family's first child to attend WCPS. In the event the first child has graduated from the program, the alumnus' original attendance date will determine priority. For the remaining 3 groups, priority is determined based on a random drawing within each group.

Applications received after the Lottery Application Deadline will be processed as they are received.

Admission

The Applications and Admissions Committee will consider each application according to rank on the priority grid established by the Woodmont Christian Preschool Board.

Classes are formed on the basis of the age of each child on September 30th. A child entering a WCPS class must be the appropriate age for that class age span by September 30th of the current school year.

The goal is to place each child in a group with which he/she can expect to attend kindergarten.

Applications reviewed and offered admission will be mailed a contract specifying the days offered and annual tuition. Applicants requesting placement in a classroom that is full will be placed on the waiting list and will be notified if an opening becomes available.

Special Needs Information

Woodmont Christian Preschool admits children of any race, color, national and ethnic origin. If a child enters the program with an identified special health care need (i.e. asthma, diabetes, seizures, hearing or vision impairments, feeding needs, urinary or other on-going health problems), the parent is responsible for notifying and providing the school specific written instructions for the child's special health needs PRIOR to a child's enrollment date. (WCPS Handbook p. 12) Children with emotional, physical or cognitive special needs will be accepted if it is determined that they will benefit from the program and the staff is able to meet their needs in addition to the needs of the other children. (WCPS Handbook p. 6)

Tuition

School hours are 9:30-2:30 each day the child attends.

Tuition is based on a 9-month school year (August – May) contract.

Total tuition is calculated based on the child's age and the number of days per week the child will attend.

Tuition rates are influenced by the classroom ratio and cost of extracurricular activities.

Contracts may be paid Annually (by July 1) or Semi-Annually (1/2 by July 1 and 1/2 by January 15)

6 months - 3 years old

2 days - \$2550 annual tuition

3 days - \$3825 annual tuition

5 days - \$6375 annual tuition

4 and 5 years old

4 days - \$4800 annual tuition (4 year old only)

5 days - \$6000 annual tuition (4 or 5 year old)

Timeline

WCPS admissions honor the Nashville Consortium of Independent Schools calendar. See timeline below for specific mailing dates. The following timeline is the typical admission process for fall applicants. We do, however, accept application all year and work with families in the spring and summer after this timeline has been completed.

January 31, 2012

2012-2013 School Year Lottery Application Deadline .

February 24, 2012

WCPS 2012-2013 School Year contracts, acceptance and wait-list letters mailed.

March 8, 2012

WCPS 2012-2013 School Year Contract forms and 15% non-refundable deposit must be received by this date.

July 1, 2012

If choosing to pay tuition annually: Full payment of annual tuition due

If choosing to pay tuition semi-annually: Half of annual tuition due

January 15, 2013

If choosing to pay tuition semi-annually: Remaining half of annual tuition due
